**“Live the life you love and love the life you live”**

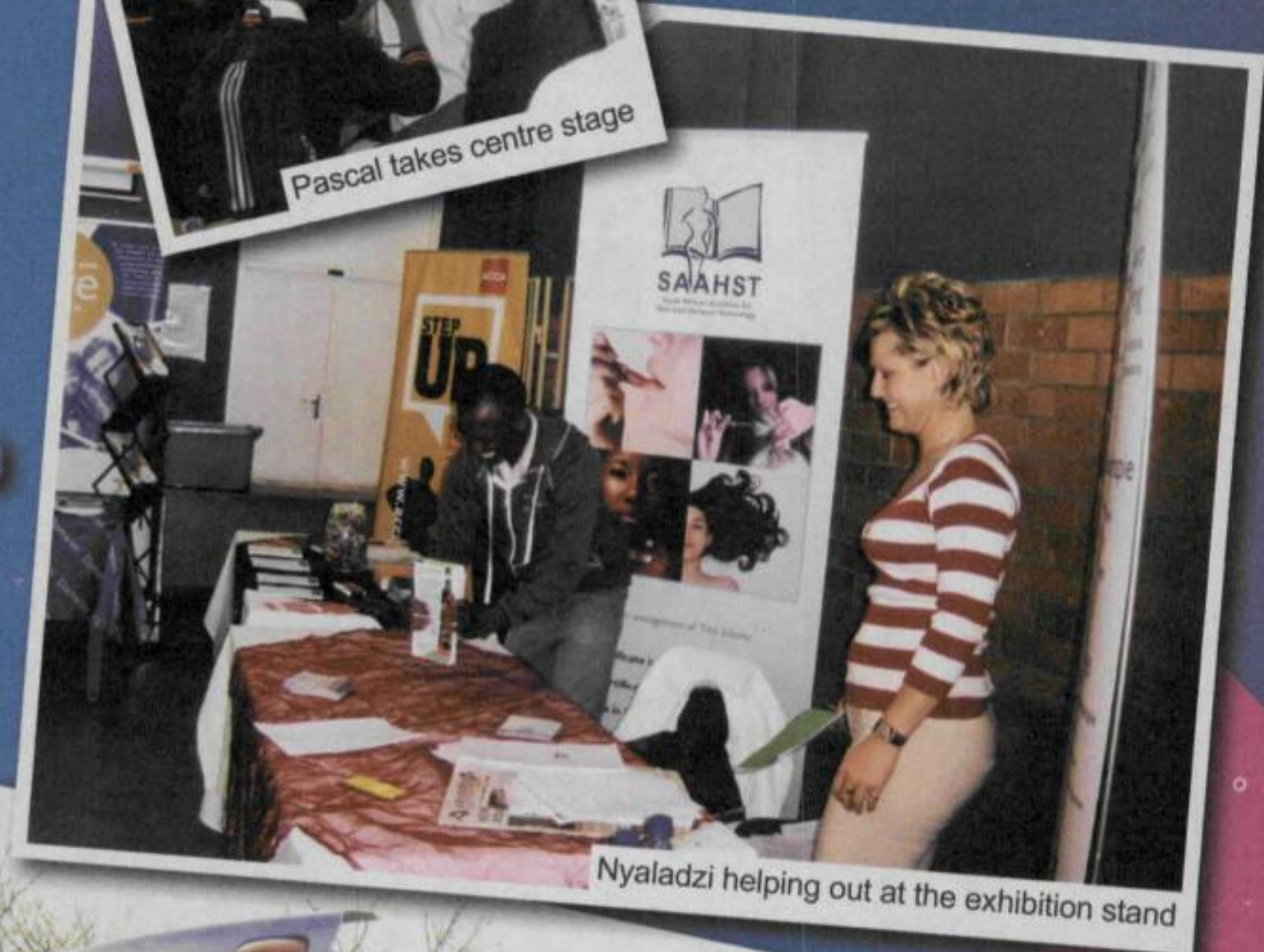

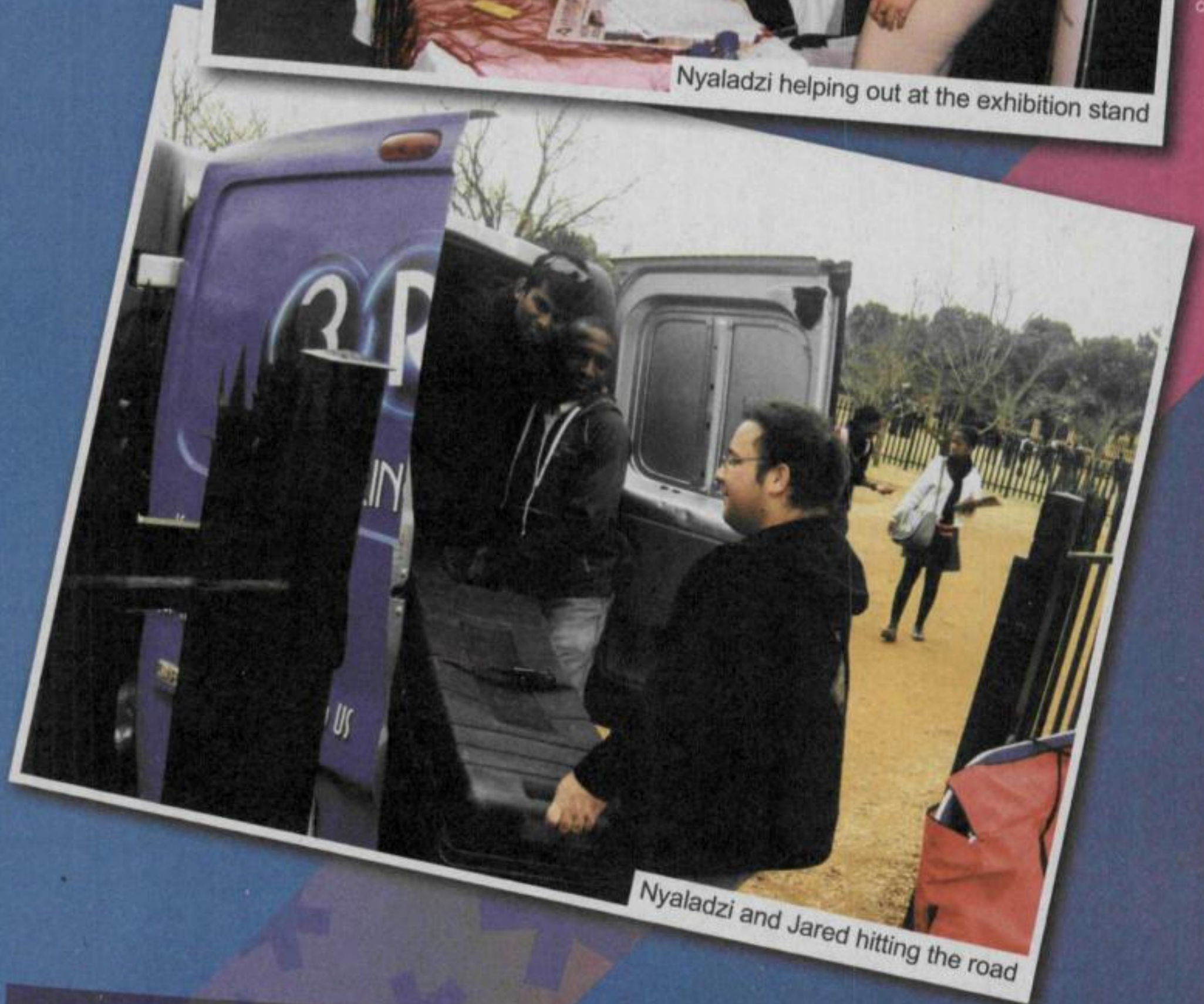
